## CONSENT FOR INFRARED COAGULATION OF HEMORRHOIDS

Date:
<b>PROCEDURE:</b> An anoscope is put into the rectum to allow the hemorrhoids to be seen. A heat producing instrument is placed on the hemorrhoid tissue and a small controlled tissue burn is made.
Rare complications include bleeding or pain. These could lead to the use of antibiotics, transfusions, hospitalization or surgery.
